The Discussion...

Create a crowd and nothing, or chaos happens. Many will not proactively speak up in a collective environment, the voice with the greatest bias will be the loudest, the voice of sanity will be under a bushel and the resulting decision is a function of the lowest common denominator.

So why do we allow these negative influences to wreak havoc on one of the most important functions of a board or an executive team?
